ABOUT THE POSITION

Every year, 3-4 students serve as Washington Program Ambassadors. Ambassadors are paraprofessionals who provide support to the Washington Program's outreach and recruitment efforts. Successful applicants will be confident, enthusiastic, positive, flexible, and knowledgeable about the program. Ambassadors who are selected agree to uphold university policies and regulations, accept assignments as directed by staff, and present a professional demeanor and appearance at all functions. This is a chance to talk about how the Washington Program enhanced your undergraduate experience!

TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Design, organize, and present at information sessions, panels, student organization meetings and classroom presentations
- Complete 5-minute class presentations for courses in which you are currently enrolled
- Share personal experiences about the Washington Program with students
- Answer questions from prospective students following presentations
- Assist Washington Program staff with UC Davis & ICC fairs
- Distribute literature and flyers, and display posters around campus
- Work in collaboration with the Washington Program team on a variety of projects

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Washington Program alumnus
- Commit to attend a minimum of 10 -15 events per quarter
- Must be comfortable with public speaking
- Must be available during evenings
- Must be team-oriented, and willing and able to work well with people of any background
