SUBJECT: Faculty Research Grants for the UC Davis Washington Program, 2008-2009

APPLICATION DEADLINE: MAY 1, 2008

Applications are now being accepted for faculty research grants sponsored by the UC Davis Washington Program. Our overall goal is to provide support for research projects that utilize the array of resources in the Washington area including historical archives, other collections in the arts, humanities, sciences and social sciences, as well as access to policy-makers for research-oriented interviews.

Because we have limited funding for research grants, we will consider proposals for individual faculty research projects up to \$2000.

Should you wish to consider submitting a proposal for additional funds, such as co-sponsoring a research conference at the Washington Center or for a long-term collaborative research project involving the Washington Program as co-sponsor with faculty and/or units on campus, including support for the development of major extramural funding, please contact Professor Larry Berman, Program Director.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

The application cover sheet and budget page are available from the UC Davis Washington Center website www.washingtonprogram.ucdavis.edu.

Application submissions must include (1) cover sheet/budget page; (2) description of the research project presenting the main project goals, discussion of the project's significance, and demonstration of the need for travel to Washington, D.C.; (3) budget elaboration and justification, and listing of other sources of financial support related to the project; and (4) brief CV that includes current position, other major positions, degrees and dates awarded, and list of publications since 1996. Estimates for hotel should not exceed \$250 per day. Housing may be available at the Washington Center at a significantly reduced rate. Maximum time at the Washington Center on a short-term research grant is two weeks (as distinct from Faculty Fellow positions, which are in-residence positions for at least one quarter and also involve teaching).

ELIGIBILITY: All members of the Academic Senate and all members of the Academic Federation with Principal Investigator status. Please note that funding is not available in the Faculty Research Grants program for graduate students or assistants to travel to Washington, DC.
