Job Description:

The National Governors Association Center for Best Practices (NGA Center) Health Division seeks a graduate summer intern with an interest in state-based health issues, including health care coverage, public health, and quality improvement.

The individual should have basic health policy and public health knowledge to assist the Health Division with various projects, including the following:

- Tracking state health care coverage initiatives;
- Compiling state-based information on public health initiatives, including state employee health programs, childhood obesity, and rewarding healthy behaviors in the public and private markets; and
- Analyzing state-based quality improvement and measurement programs.

Responsibilities

General responsibilities include:

- Providing research assistance in health policy and public health areas;
- Summarizing research and policy papers for NGA Center newsletters, briefs, and reports;
- Collecting and monitoring state trends and best practices;
- Drafting policy papers, briefs, and reports;
- Attending meetings and preparing summaries;
- Updating Health Division web pages; and
- Assisting with the preparation of meetings and conferences.

Requirements

Candidates should have interest and/or background in state-based health issues, strong analytical skills, excellent writing and oral communications skills, and a strong academic record.
