

Research Fellowship/Teaching Assistant Position:

Applications are now being accepted for two (2) positions as UC Davis Washington Program Graduate Fellows for the 2009-2010 academic year.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: MARCH 4, 2009

The positions are a combination of pre-doctoral research fellowships and teaching assistantships for the UC Davis Washington Undergraduate Program. The undergraduate program operates on a full year academic calendar – Fall, Winter, and Spring Quarters.

Graduate Fellows are provided office space with computer and some services in the UC Washington Center (located at 1608 Rhode Island Ave., NW, Washington, DC). Depending on availability, graduate students may live in the Washington Center building or they can make other living arrangements in the area.

STIPEND

The current nine-month academic year stipend for the Washington Program Graduate Fellows is \$16,637. Graduate Fellows also receive a \$500 travel stipend. In recent years, graduate fellows have been provided with an additional academic year stipend and a housing allowance (subject to applicable tax laws) to help defray the cost of living in or near the Washington, DC area. Due to the uncertainty of the State's financial climate, next year's program budget has not been finalized. At this time we are not able to confirm the stipend or housing allowance but expect this information will become available in the near future (or prior to your appointment).

ELIGIBILITY

Positions are open to graduate students from all departments and graduate programs, with some preference for those with significant teaching experience in the social sciences or humanities. Applications are particularly encouraged from students whose doctoral research would significantly benefit from a period of residence in Washington, D.C. Applicants must be graduate students who have not exceeded university regulations on the number of quarters of TA eligibility. Preference is given to applications for the full academic year, primarily for reasons of continuity in the undergraduate teaching program, but the Program will consider applications for a shorter period of time.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES
