I also saw Pres Bush, VP Cheney, Secty of State, and other high ranking administration officials. I also did one-minute new stories for Free Speech Radio News. I wrote the script, conducted an interview and recorded and edited sound. I worked hard. Staff expectations are high and they get upset if you do not perform. However, this was laid out at the beginning. I’m extremely glad I got this internship; it allowed me to experience Washington in a way I never would have otherwise.”

Another Davis student said, “I was given a minidisk recorder and a reporter pad and set loose upon DC. As this internship you’ll become fully press credentialed, so you can walk freely throughout the halls of Congress, etc. I was even able to go to the White House Correspondents dinner. I have met, spoken to or recorded: Sen Hillary Clinton, Rep Rahm Emmanuel, Brooke Shields, Newt Gingrich, Henry Kissinger, Tim McGraw, Faith Hill, Speaker Nancy Pelosi and on and on.”
