Here is what Ms. Nelson has to say about the internship and how to apply:

The Office of Public Affairs at the Justice Department is responsible for ensuring that the public and press are informed about the Department's activities and about the priorities and policies of the Attorney General and the President with regard to law enforcement and legal affairs.

Our interns assist with many administrative functions (answering phones, providing general office support, etc.), but are also assist with drafting and editing press releases and helping with coordination of Department press conferences and other open press events.

Applicants should be forewarned that there is a lengthy application process involved for federal government jobs and that it may take up to several weeks for them to gain clearance prior to starting in our office should they be offered a position for the term.
