Infant and Toddler Mental Health Program Internship Description

Children's National Medical Center's Department of Psychiatry offers an internship opportunity to qualified undergraduates interested in gaining clinical research experience. Interns will work under two child psychiatrists in the Infant and Toddler Mental Health Program, assisting with several ongoing studies. Specifically, the studies focus on behavior problems in toddlers and feeding disorders in infants and young children.

Major responsibilities may include:

- Coding of videotaped sessions
- Scoring questionnaires
- Literature searches
- Data management
- Recruitment and management of study participants
- Miscellaneous administrative and organizational duties
- Participation in clinical observation and discussion team

A qualified student should have completed some coursework in psychology and/or related field. He/she should express interest in the research process, particularly with a young population. Skills in Microsoft Excel and Word are preferred.
