ABOUT THE POSITION

Washington Program Ambassadors are paraprofessionals who provide support to the Washington Program's outreach and recruitment efforts. TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Accept responsibility for all tasks as assigned
- Deliver 5-minute classroom presentations for courses in which you are currently enrolled
- Share your individual experience in the Washington Program with students
- Answer questions and direct inquiries from prospective students
- Assist Washington Program staff with UC Davis & ICC fairs
- Distribute brochures and flyers, and assist with general marketing and outreach
- Present at information sessions, panels, and student organization meetings

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Washington Program alumni
- Must be comfortable with public speaking
- Must be available during early mornings as well as evenings
- Must be team-oriented and able to work well with people from all backgrounds
